Technical Committee

1. Definition and structure

- 1.1. The National Ranking is a list of Players / pairs in order of the points achieved during the stipulated period and according to the criteria. There is a separate list for each of the Badminton Events in the National Ranking. The system used to rank Players / pairs is explained below:
- 1.2. Players / pairs:
 - 1.2.1. win ranking points by playing in Tournaments that are graded and are ranked if they have played in one or more graded Tournaments in the last 52 weeks.
 - 1.2.2. ranking points will be awarded according to the achievement of each tournament. The further reached in a competition, the more points are won.
 - 1.2.3. the higher the level of Tournament, the more points are won.
 - 1.2.4. can be seeded based on their Ranking.

2. Tournaments included in the Rankings

- 2.1. The National Rankings are compiled from the results of Tournaments that are sanctioned by the Sri Lanka Badminton held over the last 52-week period. All Tournaments eligible, and the details of the grade are published in the Calendar of Tournaments.
- 2.2. Points from a sanctioned Tournament will stay on the National Rankings until the next same sanctioned Tournament (same grade and level) is held, for 52 weeks, or whichever comes first.

3. National Ranking Lists publication

- 3.1. The National Rankings are published ONE week after every tournament finishes.
- 3.2. The complete Ranking lists are available on the SLB Official web site:

4. Points System

- 4.1. Players / pairs win points according to how far they have achieved in the draw of particular event.
- 4.2. If a Player / pair
 - 4.2.1. had a BYE in the first round and lost in second round, they received second round points.
 - 4.2.2. lost in the first round in main draw when qualifying draw available, they will receive ranking points.
 - 4.2.3. play directly in main draw when qualifying draw is not available, first round loser receive no ranking points
- 4.3. Players / pairs are ranked using points. The Player / pair with the highest calculated points will be ranked number one and so on.
- 4.4. If two or more Players / pairs have identical points then the players / pair have played most tournaments will be considered as higher ranker. If the players / pairs have identical points and no of tournaments, players / pairs ranked equal.
- 4.5. Players / pair who achieve international points for a particular event, total of the same (according to the international ranking criteria) will be accumulated to local points earned. The International points will revise in Third Wednesday of each month.
- 4.6. Junior players are eligible to carry forward the total points of their **BEST SIX** achievements during the current year to next age group.

5. Ranking

5.1. National Ranking – Six or fewer ranking tournaments in the last 52 weeks

If a player or pair competed in the same event at 6 or fewer National Ranking Tournaments, ranking will be worked out by accumulating the points won at the tournaments.

5.2. National Ranking – Seven or more ranking tournaments in the last 52 weeks

If a player or pair competed in the same event at 7 or more National Ranking Tournaments, only the 6 highest points scored in the tournaments during the previous 52 week period count towards their ranking.

6. Points Lists
