Rules & Regulations

1	The 68th – Sri Lanka Badminton Nationals 2020 will be held from 17th to 21st February 2021 at the Sri Lanka Badminton and Mercantile Badminton Association, Indoor Stadiums, Colombo. (Final Date May Be changed) Participation will be open only to Sri Lankan Nationals.
2	All Events will be National Ranking Level I Events
3	Entry Forms are available at SLB office and on the SLBA website and should be handed over to SLB @ Maitland Place, Colombo 7, from 09:00 am – 05:00 pm on weekdays & 09:00 am – 01:00 pm on Saturdays. Please obtain a Receipt of the Entry & Payment made.
4	All Entry Fees should be paid at the time of submitting entry. Entry is not officially accepted if payment is not made with the entry form to SLB. All cheques should be drawn in favor of “Sri Lanka Badminton Association” and crossed “Account Payee Only” or fees deposited to Account Number 0002323122 of Bank of Ceylon, Torrington Branch – Colombo – 07, and the deposit slip handed over with entry form.
5	Age will be calculated as at 01 January 2021 for Under 15, Under 17 and Under 19 and at 01 January 2020 for Veteran and Masters Events.
6	Feather shuttlecocks of a Li Ning brand will be used for all the events.
7	Competitors will be allowed to take part in only one age category and any number of open events. Participants for OPEN EVENTS should be above 15 years of age as at 01 January 2020. For all other events, participants should be above 13 years of age.
8	A Plate Singles event will be played for Men’s/Women’s singles . 01 st match losers of the main draw are entitled to play this event. Losers by conceding of walkovers are not entitled to play in this event
9	Seeded Players in the MS & WS of this Championship, former Plate Winners within the last 3 years and Q/Finalists in National Ranking Events are not entitled to take part in this event.
10	The Championships will run on a knockout basis and all matches will be played per the rules and regulations of Badminton approved by the BWF and as adopted by SLB . All players will be subject to the Players Code of Conduct of BWF . Violation of same would form the basis for disciplinary action as deemed appropriate by SLB. It is Mandatory that from Quarter Final onwards, the opposing players in each match shall wear significantly different colors from each other. It is Mandatory for Doubles Partners to wear the same colors of shirts and shorts from Quarter Finals onwards.
11	If a player/ pair is disqualified for any offense within or outside the court, the result of the last match played by that player/pair will be cancelled and a walkover awarded to the opponents of that last match, prior to the disqualification.
12	The tournament committee may cancel an event in the Championships if there are less than four (4) entries. For Veterans events, if there are less than (4) entries, the organizer will amalgamate these entries into the nearest lower age group. If Over 35 age group has less than 4 entries, the event will be cancelled or amalgamated with the Open Events.
13	Depending on the number of entries, the tournament committee may conduct qualifying rounds. If there will be an excessive number of entries, matches will be started before the scheduled dates and in separate venues, if needed.
14	Players are entitled to a minimum of 60 minutes’ rest period between any two matches.
15	Players must be punctual and any player who does not turn up for his/her match at the time allotted, will be liable to have a walkover given against him/her. Ten minutes (10 mts.) grace will be allowed. No postponements shall be allowed under any circumstances.
16	Competitors shall be allowed to play with the Doubles Partner nominated by them in the entry form. Partner’s name should necessarily be indicated in the Entry Form. Entry forms without partner’s name will not be accepted.
17	No substitutions are permitted for seeded players in any doubles events. All other competitors will be allowed to substitute a partner if his original partner is prevented from playing through illness, injury or other unavoidable hindrance. The affected player will not be allowed to play in any other event on that day. Such proposed substitute shall be notified to the Tournament Referee or Deputy Referee or to an Appointed Official in writing, before the commencement of that particular event. Such substitution should not be of a higher rank than the original player and the new combination should not be of a standard higher than the original combination. The substitute should not have entered the same event separately.
18	The Referee shall be in overall charge of the tournament of which a match forms part. The decision of the umpire shall be final on any matter of fact in the match of which he/she is umpiring.
19	All disputes with regard to the Championships shall be referred to the Referee or the Tournament Committee. On all matters connected with the tournament and on any matters not provided for, the decision of the Tournament Committee shall be final and binding on all participants.
20	If a player concedes a walkover in any event due to injury/illness or absence, he/she will not be permitted

	to compete in any other event of the tournament on the same day .
21	Applicants must be fit and in good health and absolutely relieve the organizers and such persons involved in the organization of the 68th National Badminton Championships 2020 , of any responsibility for any injury, loss or damages to his/her property which he/she sustain in the courts or in connection with the above tournament.
22	Participants in Senior/Junior Events must produce the NIC, Passport or Birth Certificate when requested by the Tournament Committee .
23	Entry forms should be handed over to Sri Lanka Badminton (SLB), Maitland Place, Colombo 07. No postal Entries and Email are also not acceptable.
24	Entries will be closed on 1st February ,2021 at 8. 00 p.m. at SLB, Maitland Place, Colombo 07.
25	Entries sent by fax which will not be accepted. Incomplete entries too will not be accepted.
26	Entry list (M & Q) will be published on SLB Web Site and displayed on the notice boards at SLB from 5th February,2021. All participants should check the list and contact the Referee if there is an error.
27	The Draw will take place on 9th February,2021 at 11.00 am. at SLB, and published on the SLB Notice Board and SLB website. (www.srilankabadminton.lk). The Draw will be conducted on tournament software of BWF and can be viewed live on the SLB FB page.
28	Prize Money Offered for the Championship is Rs. 1,000,000.00 . Certificates & Trophies/Medals will be awarded to all Winners, Runners-Up & Semi-Finalists of the Championships, depending on the number of entries,
29	The last date for Withdrawal without penalty will be the 8th February,2021. Such withdrawals should be notified in writing to the SLB Secretariat and an acknowledgment obtained. Withdrawal after the draw is published on the 6th February,2021 will carry a penalty of Rs.2000.00 If the player fails to make the penalty by due date, he will not be entertained for future tournaments. The due date will be 14 days after the conclusion of the tournament.
